Dear Parents,

The Education Accountability Act of 2009 requires all public schools in Colorado to develop Unified Improvement Plans (UIP). The UIP outlines performance targets and strategies that the school will implement to increase academic achievement. Schools are assigned a plan type of performance, improvement, priority improvement, or turnaround based on performance indicator ratings on the School Performance Framework (SPF). A rating of “Performance” is the highest rating a school can be assigned.

Here are the preliminary results from the Golden High School SPF:

The preliminary SPF report for Golden High School is available in the main office. The final SPF will be issued from the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) and will be available online in mid-December 2012 at www.schoolview.org.

The UIP development timeline for Golden High School is as follows:

August 2012	Initial SPF from CDE
September 2012	School level meetings to review & update UIP
October 2012	Initial UIP due for district review
December 2012	UIP revisions, if needed, returned to schools
December 2012	Final SPF from CDE
January 15, 2013	UIP submitted to CDE

Jefferson County Public Schools is required to submit Golden High School’s UIP to CDE.

As part of the UIP process, Golden High School will hold an Accountability Committee meeting on **December 4th** at 3:00 pm in the main office conference room to review the GHS UIP. For more information, please contact me at 303-982-4200.
